## Math Placement

KU Requires that students know their math placement before they enroll for their first semester. If you don't have a recent ACT/SAT score, then we recommend students take the free ALEKS math placement exam:

SAT 650+ = awarded credit from ENGL 101

### ACT of 27 or higher/SAT of 650 or higher\*

Awarded 3 credits for ENGL 101

Placed into ENGL 102

\*Based on English sub-score of test
