KU Requires that students know their math placement before they enroll for their first semester. If you don't have a recent ACT/SAT score, then we recommend students take the free ALEKS math placement exam:

### No ACT/SAT Score

Placed into ENGL 101

### ACT below 27/SAT below 630\*

Placed into ENGL 101

ACT 27+ or = awarded credit from ENGL 101

SAT 630+ = awarded credit from ENGL 101

### ACT of 27 or higher/SAT of 630 or higher\*

Awarded 3 credits for ENGL 101

Placed into ENGL 102

\*Based on English sub-score of test
